Dear Parents / Guardians,

Year 10 students will have Mock Examinations in all subjects in the week beginning Monday 29th April, ending on Friday 10th May. Speaking exams for French and Spanish will be arranged after this period.

During the mock examination period students should arrive in school by 8.45am each morning in full school uniform. Some examinations start at 9.05am so punctuality is imperative. Students will register with their form tutors as normal each morning and then be sent to the Gym. After registration if students do not have an examination they will go to their usual lessons. Students must check their normal and exam timetables and ensure they bring appropriate books and files to these lessons. Some afternoon examinations start at 2pm so students will need to be aware of afternoon start times and arrive at the Gym 15 minutes prior to the start of their examination.

Students should arrive at exams with all the necessary equipment (e.g. a black pen and a spare, calculator, ruler etc) in a clear plastic bag or pencil case.

The timetable for the exams is attached. Your son's teachers will advise as to what he needs to revise and how to prepare for each exam. Staff in all subjects may not set other homework during the exam weeks.

If a student should fall ill during the mock examination period, the school office should be contacted before 9am by parents/ carers. On return, the student should check the mock timetable and arrive at the gym for the next available catch-up session.

It is important that students prepare fully for these exams. Thank you for your support in encouraging your son to plan revision time carefully and to come to school fully equipped with both stationery and revision materials for form time/lesson time during this period.

Notes for Parents and Students

Students are to wait outside the exam room, quietly, until asked to go inside. There is to be no talking in the exam room before, during or after the exam. Bags should be left outside the room, only taking in pen, pencil, calculator etc as required for each exam, no books unless specified by subject teachers. Pencil cases are to be transparent. Mobile phones must be switched off and will be collected in by an invigilator before the exam commences. In the unlikely event of a student not being present for an exam, the student will be expected to sit the missed exam in the earliest catch-up session that they do not have a timetabled mock exam.

In relation to afternoon examinations, students who are entitled to additional time should take this into consideration when organising methods of transport home.
